#### **Special Aspects**

Fairly typical count for us; good species total of 106.

New this year was a Black-legged Kittiwake.

We've seen a meteoric rise in Black Vulture, recorded just three times: 1 in 2019, 14 in 2021, and 66 in 2022.

New high counts this year for Black Vulture (66), Turkey Vulture (7), Bonaparte's Gull (65), Rock Pigeon (365), and Eurasian Collared-Dove (61). Least Sandpiper (8) tied a record set in 2016.

The 1 Horned Lark ties for the lowest recorded on our count since 1990. Hermit Thrush has appeared in 27 counts, but not this year. Bewick's Wren recorded in 36 CBCs, but not this year.
